**Budget 2021** is a historic investment which puts people first, creates jobs, will grow the middle class, set businesses on a track for long-term growth, and ensure that Canada's future will be healthier, more equitable, greener, and more prosperous. **Budget 2021 will:**

- Support businesses in our most affected sectors such as tourism and arts and culture.
- Accelerate investment in digital transformation of small and medium-sized businesses.
- \$470 million in funding over three years to establish a new **Apprenticeship Service**, supporting 55,000 first-year apprentices in construction and manufacturing Red Seal trades connect with opportunities at small and medium-sized employers
- New Training and Work Opportunities for Canadian youth: Student Work Placement Program (\$239.8 million), Youth Employment and Skills Strategy (\$109.3 million), **Canada Summer Jobs** (\$371.8 million)
- A new **Skills for Success program** that will help Canadians at all skills levels improve their skills.
- Supports for a Canada-wide early learning and childcare system.
- Increase to Canada Workers Benefit, increasing support to over 1 million Canadians and lifting nearly 100,000 people out of poverty.
- Enhancement of Employment Insurance sickness benefits from 15 to 26 weeks.
- Commitment to closing the gaps between Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples through an historic investment of over \$18 billion annually.
- Ensuring a high standard in long-term care homes with \$3 billion in funding over five years.
- A Green recovery which fights climate change and will invest in world-leading technologies that make industry cleaner and reduces pollution, while creating good middle-class jobs in the green economy along the way.

Le budget 2021 va soutenir les entreprises dans nos secteurs les plus touchés tels que le tourisme et les arts et la culture, accélérer les investissements dans la transformation numérique des petites et moyennes entreprises, un financement de 470 millions de dollars sur trois ans pour établir un nouveau service d'apprentissage, aidant 55 000 apprentis de première année dans les métiers de la construction et de la fabrication Sceau rouge à se connecter aux opportunités offertes par les petits et moyens employeurs, des nouvelles opportunités de formation et de travail pour les jeunes Canadiens: des programme de stages pratiques pour étudiants (239,8 millions de dollars), stratégie emploi et compétences jeunesse (109,3 millions de dollars), emplois d'été Canada (371,8 millions de dollars), un nouveau programme Skills for Success qui aidera les Canadiens à tous les niveaux de compétences à améliorer leurs compétences, l'appui à un système d'apprentissage et de garde des jeunes enfants à l'échelle du Canada, l'augmentation de l'allocation canadienne pour les travailleurs, augmentant le soutien à plus d'un million de Canadiens et sortant près de 100 000 personnes de la pauvreté, bonification des prestations de maladie de l'assurance-emploi de 15 à 26 semaines, l'engagement à combler les écarts entre les peuples autochtones et non autochtones grâce à un investissement historique de plus de 18 milliards de dollars par an, assurer une norme élevée dans les foyers de soins de longue durée avec un financement de 3 milliards de dollars sur cinq ans, une relance verte qui lutte contre le changement climatique et investira dans des technologies de pointe qui rendent l'industrie plus propre et réduisent la pollution, tout en créant de bons emplois pour la classe moyenne dans l'économie verte en cours de route, et plus. The historic federal investment of **\$420 million** will allow Algoma Steel to transition to **electric-arc furnace** production and eliminate coal-fired processes, **cutting greenhouse gas** emissions by more than three million metric tonnes a year by 2030, making a meaningful contribution to achieving Canada's climate goals, the equivalent of removing over 900,000 passenger vehicles off the road. This investment will **anchor Algoma Steel** in Sault Ste. Marie for **generations to come**.

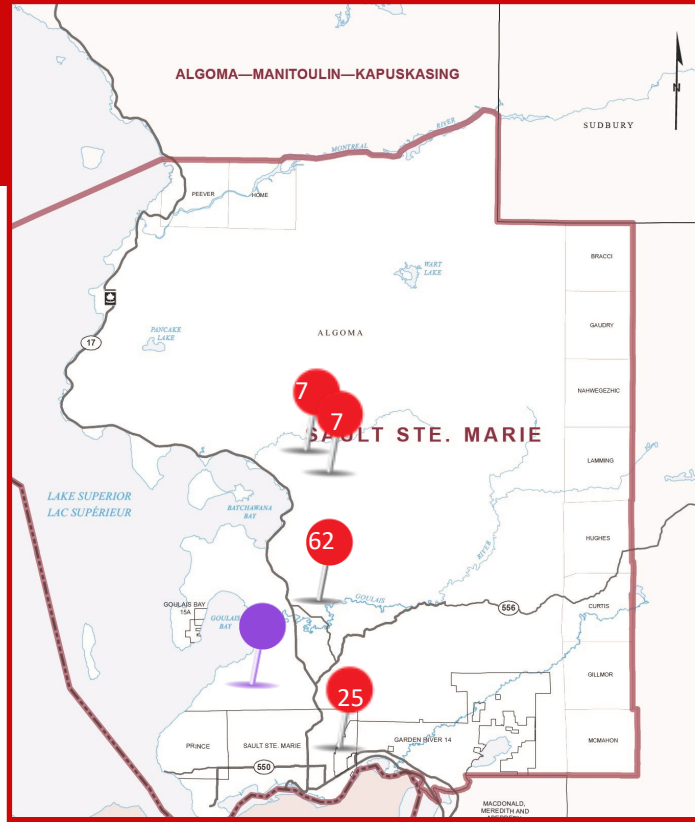
### Regional Relief and Recovery Fund

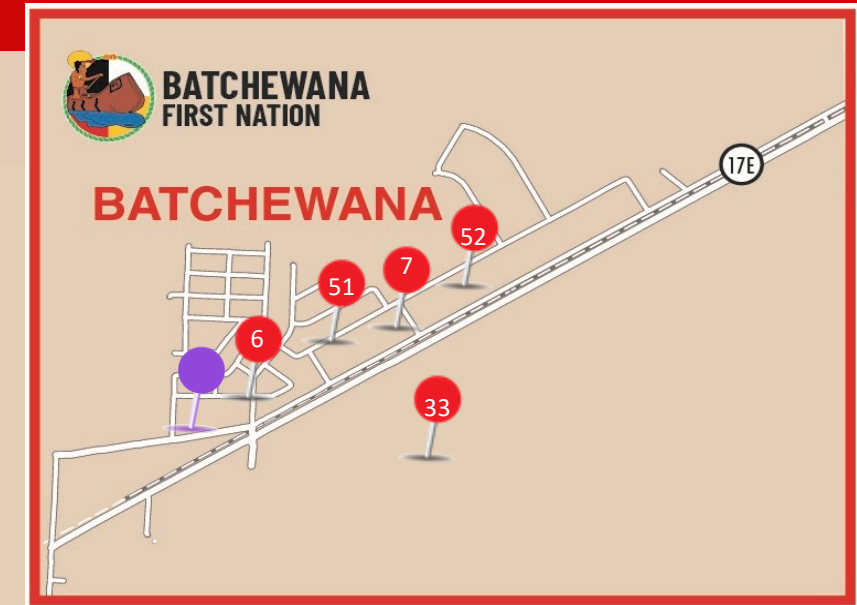
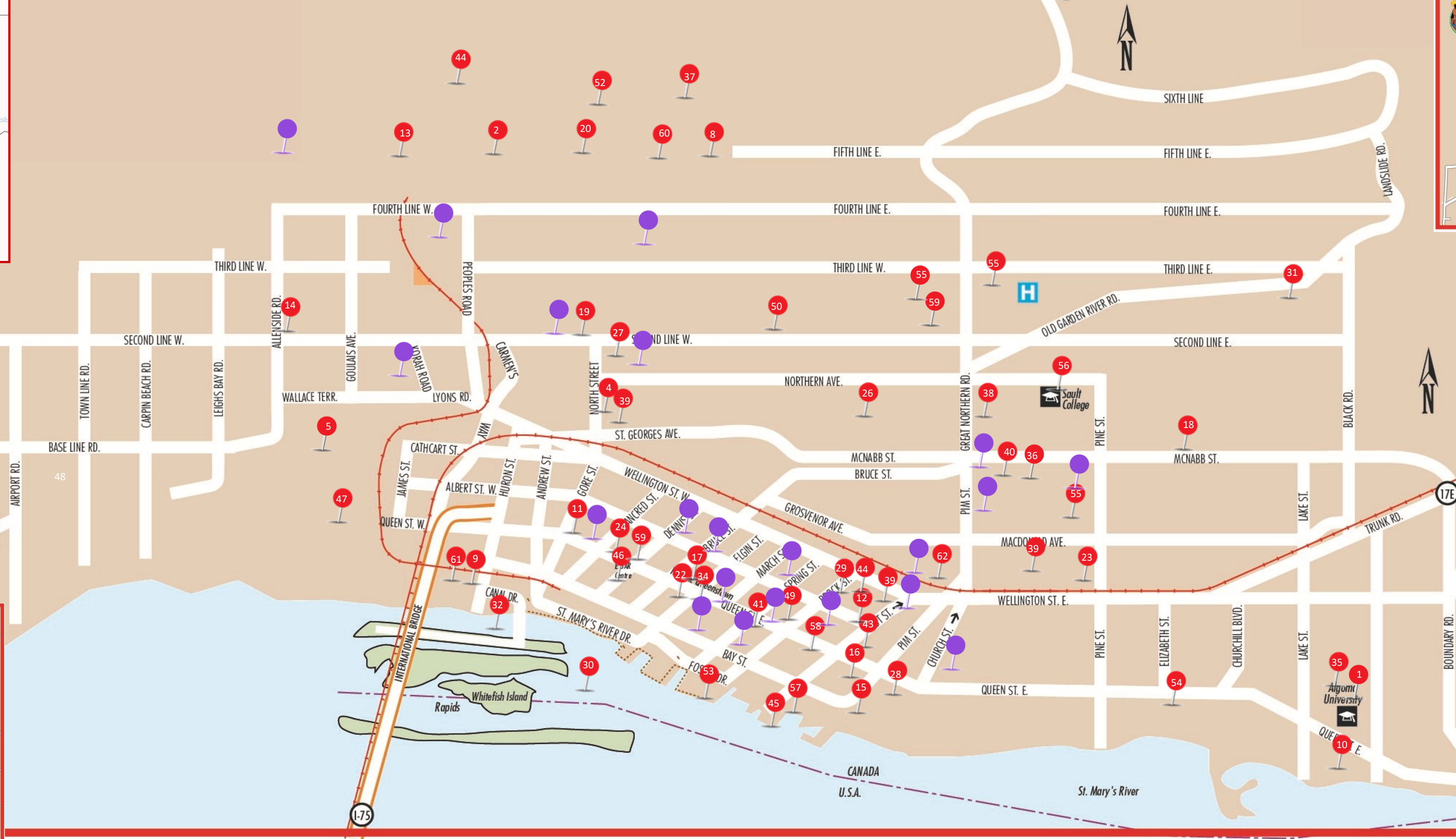

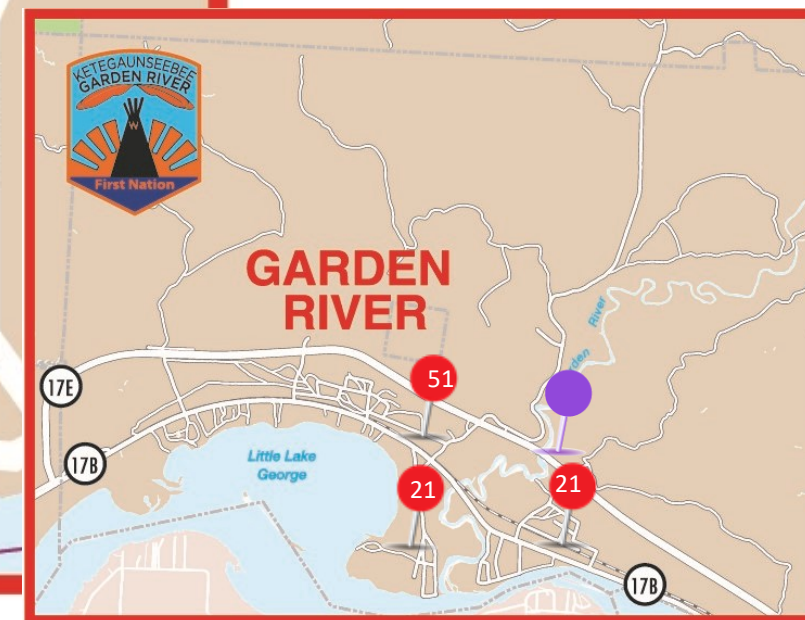
