The historic federal investment of **\$420 million** will allow Algoma Steel to transition to **electric-arc furnace** production and eliminate coal-fired processes, **cutting greenhouse gas** emissions by more than three million metric tonnes a year by 2030, making a meaningful contribution to achieving Canada's climate goals, the equivalent of removing over 900,000 passenger vehicles off the road. This investment will **anchor Algoma Steel** in Sault Ste. Marie for **generations to come**.
